Fanny Levitan, long standing member of ORMTA - Central Toronto Branch, passed away on October 16, 2001 after courageously battling many health problems. Fanny worked tirelessly in various capacities within the ORMTA for many years, including being Treasurer of Metro Toronto Zone (now named GTA Zone) and a Zone Representative on Provincial Council. Fanny was one of those exceptional individuals who made her impact felt from Ottawa to Thunder Bay and points in between.

In recognition of her many years of service to the organization, the Central Toronto Branch established a new Scholarship-Bursary in Fanny's name. This award may be presented each year to a qualifying student at the [GTA Zone competition](#), an event which features some of the most talented music students of ORMTA members in the Greater Toronto Area.
